Türkiye wants to broaden its tourism offering

Sun and beaches, as well as high-quality hotels, are the main reasons for holidaying in Türkiye. The country is diversifying its offering, aiming to target specific groups of holidaymakers and promote regions away from the coast, reported cultural attaché Ahmet Alemdar at the fvw|TravelTalk Kongress.

or German tour operators and travel agencies, Türkiye is a real heavyweight as a travel destination and ranks second after Spain in terms of turnover. In terms of the summer season, the two destinations are neck and neck. Dertour reports that Türkiye is even the most important destination for its own tour operator brands this summer, accounting for 23% of guests. The country also plays in the top league Ministry of Culture and Tourism and of tourism worldwide. "With 60 million visitors, 6.6 million of whom came from Germany, we were one of the top four destinations worldwide in 2024, according to UN Tourism," said Ahmet Alemdar, cultural attaché at the Turkish Embassy in Berlin.

Business was slightly weaker in this year's summer season compared to the record year of 2024. However, when hotel and flight prices fell in the lastminute business, numerous families still booked at short notice, reported Martin Zier (Check24) and Lars Ludwig (LMX Touristik) during a panel discussion at the congress.

There is even strong demand for the autumn, which is also very pleasant in terms of climate, with leading carrier Sun Express adding extra flights for the October holidays, said sales director Helmut Wölfel. This is also confirmed

by TUI Germany. According to a recent evaluation by the tour operator, Antalya tops the list of the most popular destinations, followed by Mallorca and Crete. Holiday destinations around the Mediterranean with reliable weather are particularly in demand.

Beach holidays on the Riviera and the Aegean remain the most important pillar of the business. However, the the marketing company TGA, which is run in conjunction with the private travel industry, want to differentiate the product and image. Alemdar outlined a

Cruise tourism is growing in Istanbul, Kusadasi and Bodrum and is set to expand further. Since the new Galataport harbour terminal opened in Istanbul at the end of October 2021, 35 million passengers have already been counted there, according to Alemdar. In addition, more and more shipping companies are stationing ships in the Bosphorus metropolis and using the base port for voyages through the eastern Mediterranean.

SPORT AND WELLNESS CULTURAL TOURISM

This sector "is one of the strongest drivers of tourism development,' said Alemdar. The country has 22 UNESCO World Heritage Sites, some of which are still true discoveries. The cultural attaché cited Göbekli Tepe in Sanliurfa in Anatolia as an example, where German archaeologists are helping to excavate what are currently the oldest known large-scale structures built by humankind.

Sustainability is of great importance, according to Alemdar. Türkiye was the first country to launch a national programme for tourism in cooperation with the recognised Global Sustainable Tourism Council (GSTC). There are certifications and initiatives for many individual areas, from 577 Blue Flag beaches and labels for cultural heritage sites to 19,460 accommodation providers that have joined the Türkiye Sustainable Tourism Programme.

"We are entering an era of tourism characterised by sustainability, digital innovation and experiential travel," said Alemdar. This will support good collaboration and trustworthy cooperation with partners from the German industry. In future, the business will continue to be supported with co-marketing campaigns for tour operators and fam trips for travel agencies.

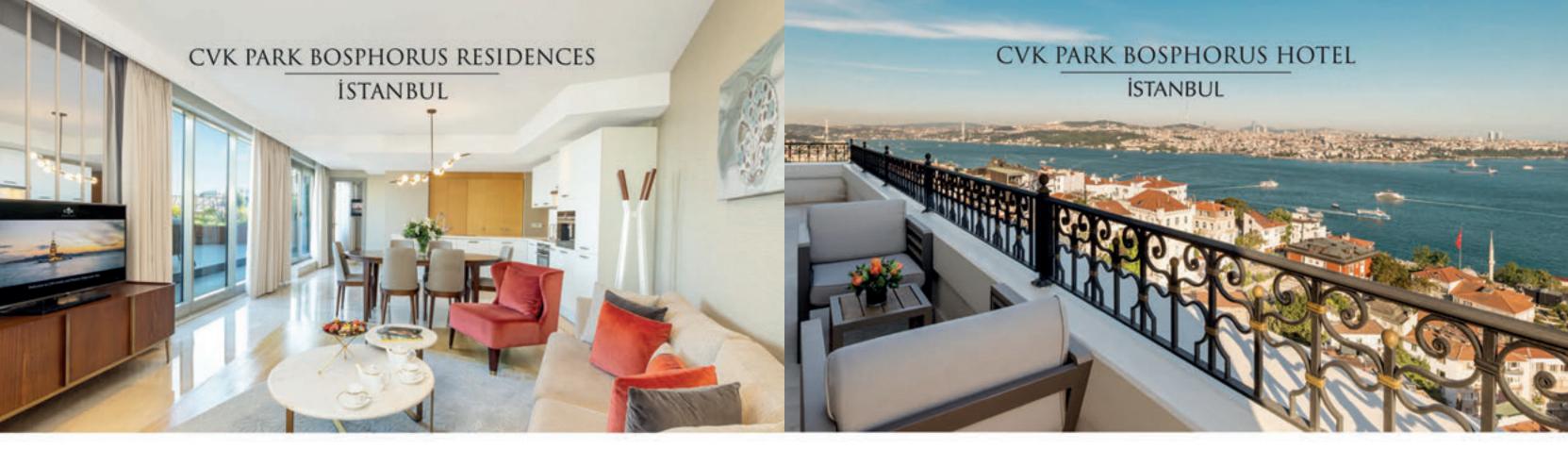

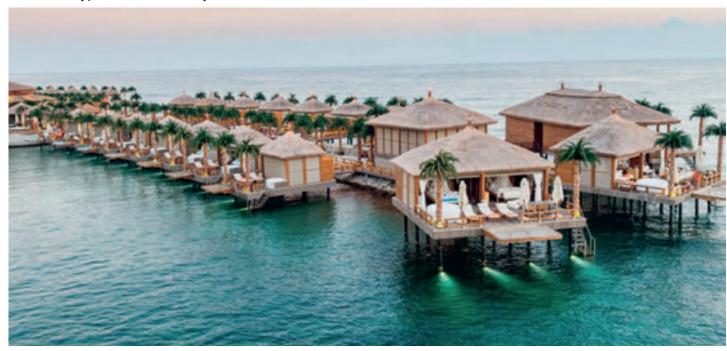

Türkiye's 'Island Cyprus' campaign to boost tourism in Turkish Cyprus

A new tourism campaign 'Island Cyprus' will help strengthen the tourism sector of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC), Türkiye's Vice President Cevdet Yılmaz said.



beaking at the Istanbul launch of the new "Island Cyprus" brand, created to promote TRNC tourism, Yılmaz said it was highly valuable and encouraging to have a master plan for tourism. Stressing that Ankara wants TRNC to reach a much stronger position in tourism, he said: "Last year, Türkiye had a tourism income exceeding \$61 billion. We hosted more than 62 million guests in our country. The TRNC Tourism Master Plan and Island Cyprus Campaign, which were introduced today, are concrete indicators of our common vision in this direction." He highlighted the TRNC's natural beauty, rich history, cultural heritage, and cuisine, noting that the Island Cyprus campaign aims to promote these assets to a wider audience and reposition the country with its unique island identity. He pointed out that millions in Türkiye have yet to visit the TRNC, adding that the Island Cyprus campaign will ignite interest and encourage more to explore the island's beauty

He noted that Türkiye has allocated 122 million Turkish liras for tourism and culture since 2024, with total financial cooperation reaching \$21 billion. He stressed Türkiye's continued support for the TRNC in various sectors, including transportation, health, education, and infrastructure, and reaffirmed commitment to both peace and prosperity through tangible projects.

Yilmaz stated that the "Century of Türkiye" would also be the "Century of the TRNC," highlighting the 2025 Economic and Financial Cooperation Agreement as a foundation for enhanced cooperation and solidarity between Türkiye and the TRNC. He also reiterated Türkiye's full support for a two-state solution, stating it as the most realistic approach for the island. He noted that past efforts at unity had failed and highlighted ongoing initiatives to make travel to the TRNC more affordable and accessible. TRNC President Ersin Tatar, speaking at

the event, highlighted tourism as key to the island's future, noting growth from five to six weekly flights in the past to 600 monthly flights now, bringing about 500,000 Turkish passengers each month. Despite isolation and restrictions, he emphasized that the tourism capacity has surpassed 35,000 with high visitor satisfaction. Tatar also drew attention to the global exposure generated through TEKNOFEST -- Türkiye's first aerospace and technology festival. "Thanks to TEKNOFEST, I saw that we managed to introduce the TRNC not only to Türkiye, but to the entire world," he said. On the Cyprus issue, Tatar stressed the TRNC's commitment to a two-state policy. "Only with this policy can the Turkish Cypriots maintain their independence and freedom. Ultimately, if there is to be a solution, in order for it to be fair and sustainable, the state of the Turkish Cypriots must absolutely be part of that agreement,"

TOLGA KİLİT: BUDGET, REVENUE AND PROFIT TARGETS FELL SHORT IN 2025

Kilit Group Board Member Tolga Kilit stated that hotels failed to meet their revenue and profitability targets in 2025.

stanbul Tourism Fair speaking at the panel "2025 Season Review and 2026 Expectations (Domestic Market)" during the Istanbul Tourism Fair, Tolga Kilit emphasized that the perception of Türkiye being "too expensive" in European markets was misleading and had negatively affected early booking performance.

EARLY BOOKING FELL SHORT AMID "TÜRKİYE IS EXPENSIVE" PERCEPTION

Kilit described 2025 as a challenging year that did not fully meet expectations. "The early booking period did not perform well for most operators. Inflation-driven pricing created a perception in Europe and the UK that Türkiye was expensive. This perception led to weaker results in the early season," he explained.

DOMESTIC MARKET BECAME MORE COMPETITIVE

As a result, the season was heavily dependent on last-minute sales, which led to significant fluctuations in pricing. "The sector was unable to apply the usual method of securing a share of capacity early on. This had negative effects on some markets, while benefiting others. Many companies, including us, adopted an unusually aggressive strategy in the domestic market," Kilit said.

REVENUE AND PROFITABILITY GOALS NOT MET

While the group managed to surpass last year's figures, it still fell short of its own financial expectations. "We



matched and slightly exceeded last year's results, but our targets were higher. The misrepresented perception that Türkiye was expensive forced us in some markets to reduce prices below the levels we had set the previous year," Kilit noted.

LESSONS FOR PRICING STRATEGY

According to Tolga Kilit, 2025 provided valuable lessons on pricing and early booking policies in an inflationary environment. "Over the past two

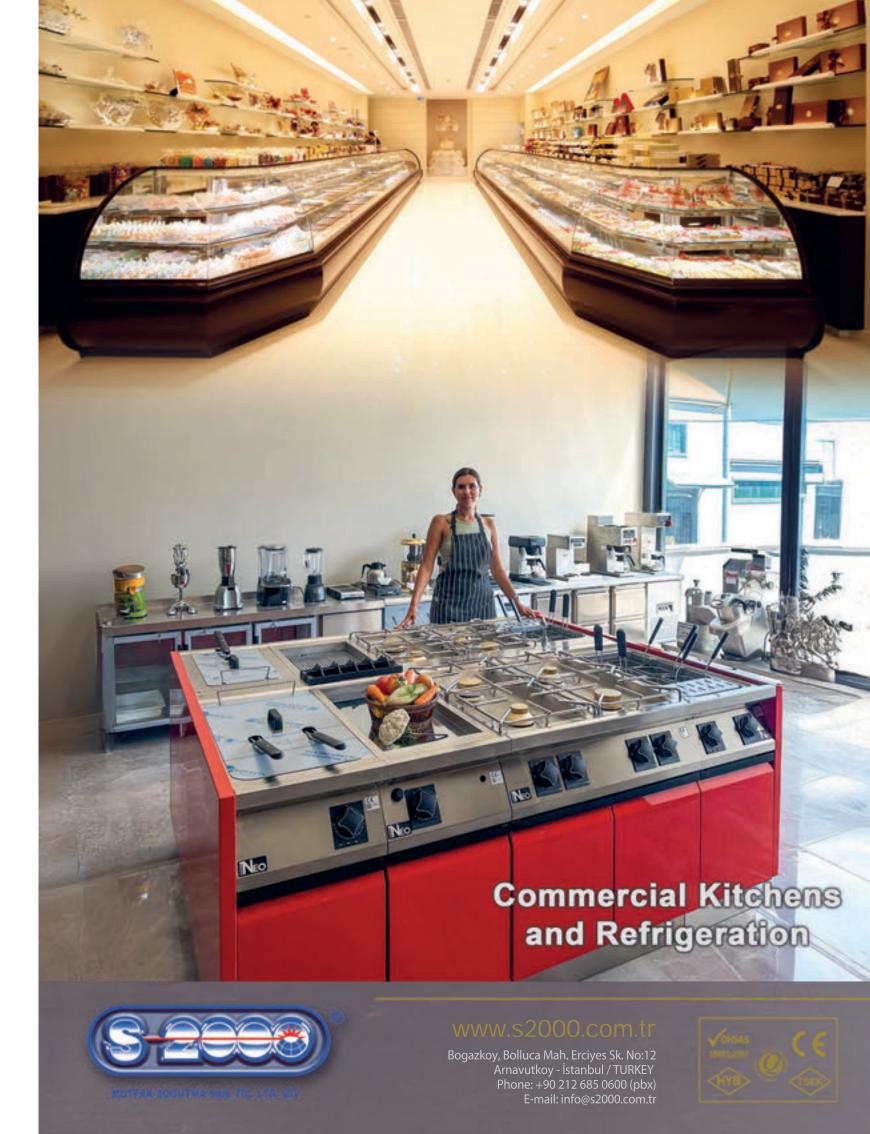
years, hotels needed to find the right balance in pricing to ensure sustainable service quality. We now see that pricing has settled at a certain level. Next year, we expect to start the season at a more optimal point and build on that," he said.

EMPLOYMENT AND THE ROLE OF ALL-INCLUSIVE TOURISM

Highlighting Antalya's importance, Kilit noted that the city hosts 850 four- and five-star hotels and resorts. With a population of 2.5 million, Antalya's workforce swells to 4 million during the summer months. "We employ around 11,500 people. Had we not entered the hotel business in 2004 and expanded to our current capacity, how would we have created this level of employment and contributed to Antalya, Türkiye, and Turkish tourism? Without the all-inclusive model, we could not have hosted such large numbers of guests," he stated. Kilit suggested that future strategies should focus on diversifying tourism offerings and segmenting the all-inclusive model.

OPTIMISM FOR 2026

Looking ahead, Kilit expressed cautious optimism. "Early booking will be critical, and we expect a highly competitive campaign. It is essential to focus on Europe and the UK and to correct the operators' perception that Türkiye is expensive. We believe our pricing is fair for the level of service provided. If we can maintain this, growth will follow. I can say with confidence that 2026 will not be worse than this year," he concluded.





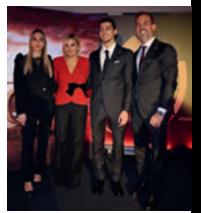

"Our mission under Dedeman Hospitality is to carry Turkish hospitality into the future with a modern approach and represent it proudly both at home and abroad," he said.

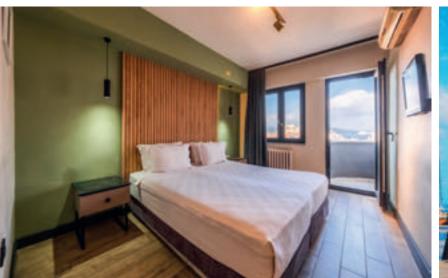

"We are developing Saudi Arabia not just for Hajj and Umrah travel but also for its sea and cultural tourism, focusing on the Red Sea and Al'Ula. In 2025, Maldives and Zanzibar packages were highly popular. In 2026, interest will continue, and destinations like Mauritius, Seychelles, and Sri Lanka will be among the preferred choices. Long-haul destinations, Asia and America tours, will still be on the radar for domestic travelers. Japan, which gained popularity in 2025, will continue to be in demand in 2026. Other options include Thailand, Vietnam, and South Korea. Another



rising star in 2026 will be Moldova, added to the list of must-visit countries."

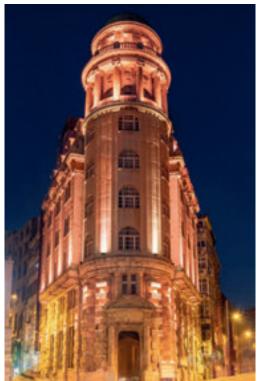

BARIŞ ÇOLAK: OUR GOAL IS MAXIMUM GUEST SATISFACTION

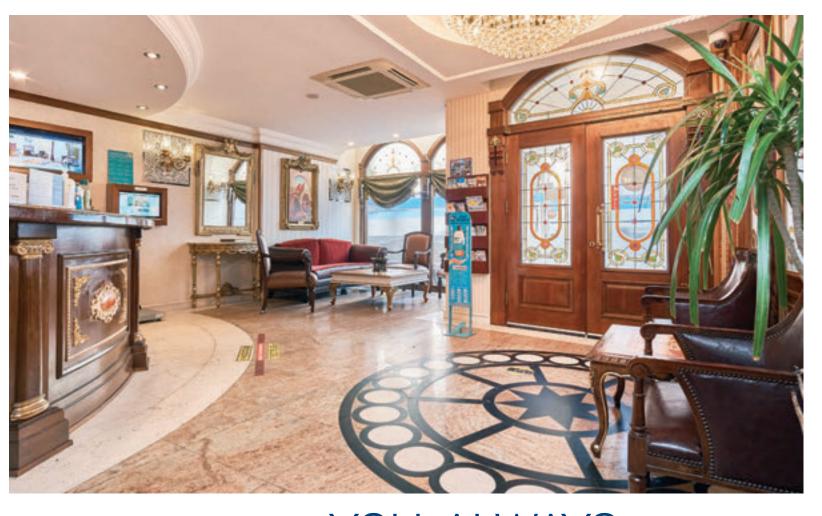
AYS Academia Board Member Barış Çolak stated: "Our

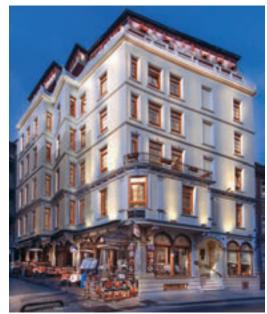

FUN&SUN TARGETS **1.2 MILLION**TOURISTS TO TÜRKİYE IN 2026

Russian tour operator FUN&SUN plans to bring 1.2 million visitors to Türkiye in 2026, according to the company's Türkiye General Manager, Oğuz Ergül.

025 Review and 2026 Expectations (Tour Operators)" during the Istanbul Tourism Fair, Oğuz Ergül, general Manager of FUN&SUN Türkiye, emphasized the importance of early bookings, market analysis, and close cooperation between hoteliers and tour operators. Ergül highlighted that Türkiye's tourism sector must learn from 2024 and 2025 in order to secure a stronger early booking season for 2026. Stressing the strategic value of the Russian market, he noted that hoteliers need to closely monitor market dynamics, customer preferences, and purchasing power. "Despite the challenges we face every year, Turkish tourism professionals deliver the best tourism service in the world," Ergül said, pointing out that while European destinations struggled during the pandemic, Türkiye's industry has built resilience through decades of adapting to crises.

2025: A CHALLENGING YEAR, BUT 1 MILLION VISITORS REACHED

FUN&SUN, which operates primarily in Antalya, will close 2025 with around one million visitors, Ergül confirmed. However, he described 2025 as "a year that fell short of overall expectations for Turkish tourism."

The company mitigated difficulties in the Russian market — strained by war and limited airline operations — by preparing for strong early bookings. "We secured nearly 40% more early reservations than expected. By anticipating a weak summer until July,



we acted early with promotions and discounts, which helped us ease the pressure," he explained.

Ergül also addressed the economic challenges facing Türkiye's hospitality industry. "In the past two years, foreign exchange rose by 20%, while hotel operating costs surged by 55%. This has seriously disrupted budget and revenue balance for hoteliers," he said. He urged stakeholders to analyze not only local competition but also pricing trends in rival destinations.

ANTALYA'S DEPENDENCE ON CHARTER FLIGHTS

Calling Antalya the world's largest charter destination, Ergül underscored its reliance on tour operators. "Unlike Spain or Italy, where airlines operate scheduled flights from major European markets every 15 minutes, Antalya's growth depends heavily on tour operators who take financial risks with charter flights," he noted. He added that while European tour operators often shift capacity to more profitable markets, Russian tour operators remain strongly committed to Türkiye, particularly Antalya and the Aegean. "Even during the pandemic, Russia remained Türkiye's most reliable market, withdrawing only after the 2015 plane crisis," Ergül reminded.

GROWTH PLANS FOR 2026

Looking ahead, FUN&SUN is optimistic. The company launched its 2026 early booking campaign in July 2025 and saw record interest. As a result, it has set a growth target of 25–30%, aiming to bring between 1.2 and 1.25 million tourists to Türkiye. While maintaining a strong focus on coastal destinations, the company also plans to expand in Istanbul. "Istanbul is a global capital for culture, art, and gastronomy. We have opened an office there and are working to grow the city's presence in the Russian market," Ergül said.

COLLABORATION BETWEEN HOTELIERS AND TOUR OPERATORS

Ergül concluded by stressing the shared responsibility between tour operators and hoteliers. "The burden falls more on hoteliers than on operators. If they analyze the season carefully, maintain close contact with us, and work together, we can overcome challenges — just as we managed this difficult summer," he

AVIATION ROOTS, TOURISM WINGS



Can an aviation-minded company land as smoothly in the competitive world of tourism as it does on a runway? Corendon Tourism Group thinks that in the garden of one of their hotels, a full-size Boeing 747 parked among the trees makes the case that it can!

he story begins in 1997, when two longtime friends — Atılay Uslu, who had built a reputation in aviation operations, and Yıldıray Karaer, whose expertise was steeped in travel agencies and guest hospitality - founded Corendon Tourism Group in Amsterdam. What started as a tour operator expanded into aviation in the early 2000s, with the company's first Eindhoven-Istanbul flight marking Corendon Airlines' debut roughly two decades ago That dual DNA, airline precision mixed with hospitality clever, would later spark one of Europe's most eye-catching hotel concepts, a retired jumbo jet transformed into an open-air landmark.

FROM SCHIPHOL'S RUNWAYS TO A HOTEL LAWN

When Dutch flag carrier KLM prepared to retire one of its iconic Boeing 747-400 jumbos, Corendon seized the opportunity. The aircraft, measuring 71 meters (233 feet) in length and 19 meters (62 feet) in width, was acquired intact, no easy feat for a structure that usually must be dismantled for transport.

In early 2019, the plane made a 12-kilometer (7-mile) overland journey from Amsterdam's Schiphol Airport to the Corendon Plaza Hotel in nearby Badhoevedorp. Moving the 160-ton jet required months of planning with local authorities and three consecutive nights of carefully choreographed logistics. Each night, the convoy inched

forward for about five hours at walking speed, crossing highways, bridges and even temporarily lifted power lines.
Two hundred engineers and rigging specialists coordinated the move, which Dutch television covered live.
Corendon officials said the operation alone cost more than 500,000 euros.
Today, the aircraft rests in the hotel's garden as if poised for take-off.

Beyond being a photogenic icon, it serves as a marketing beacon linking Corendon's two worlds: aviation and hospitality. Guests can walk beneath the wings, attend guided tours, or book special events inside the fuselage. To celebrate the project, Dutch tattooartist-turned-painter Lieuwe van Gogh was commissioned to design an exterior mural. The artwork in bold

lines and cobalt blues depicts themes of travel and freedom, making the Corendon 747 arguably the first retired jetliner in the world to wear a full-scale tattoo-style illustration.

The jumbo's success reshaped Corendon's view of what hotel amenities could be. Sensing visitors' fascination with aviation nostalgia, the company later introduced a "737 Suite" at its Corendon City Hotel Amsterdam New West property, a guest room whose interior replicates a narrowbody aircraft cabin complete with cockpit-style controls. The novelty proved so popular that the suite is often booked months in advance.

HH AVIATION MEETS HOSPITALITY

For industry analysts, the Corendon case shows that an airline's operational knowhow can cross-pollinate with tourism branding. By turning an engineering challenge into a public spectacle and by offering immersive aviation-themed stays, the group has crafted a narrative that differentiates it from standard city hotels.

As Uslu has noted in past interviews, "A plane in the garden tells our story better than any billboard." In an era when travelers increasingly seek "experiences" rather than just beds, the sight of a gleaming white jumbo jet parked amid a four-star property may be Corendon's ultimate calling card—a reminder that sometimes the most memorable check-in begins on the tarmac.

GlobeMeets will remain boutique, intimate, and special. And I am announcing here for the first time: next year, on the same dates, it will take place here again, in this very hall."

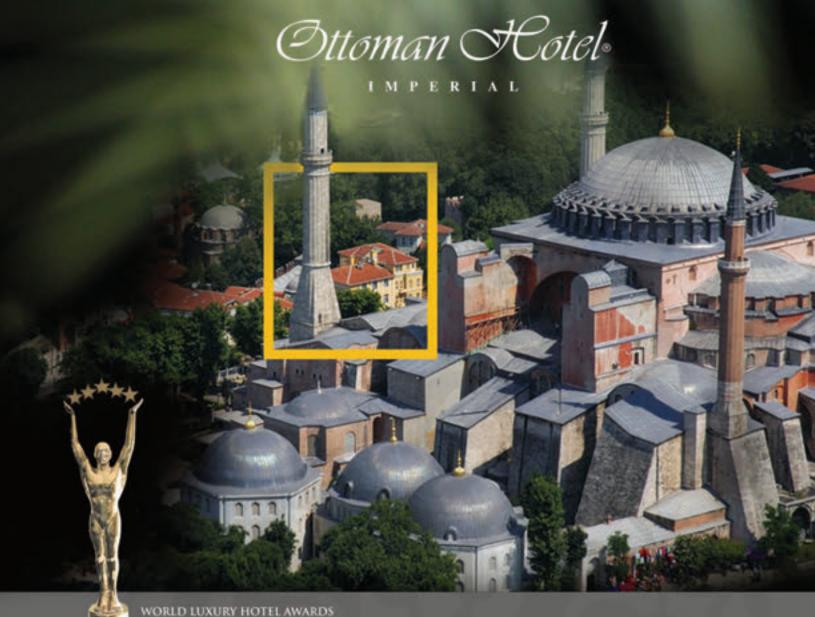

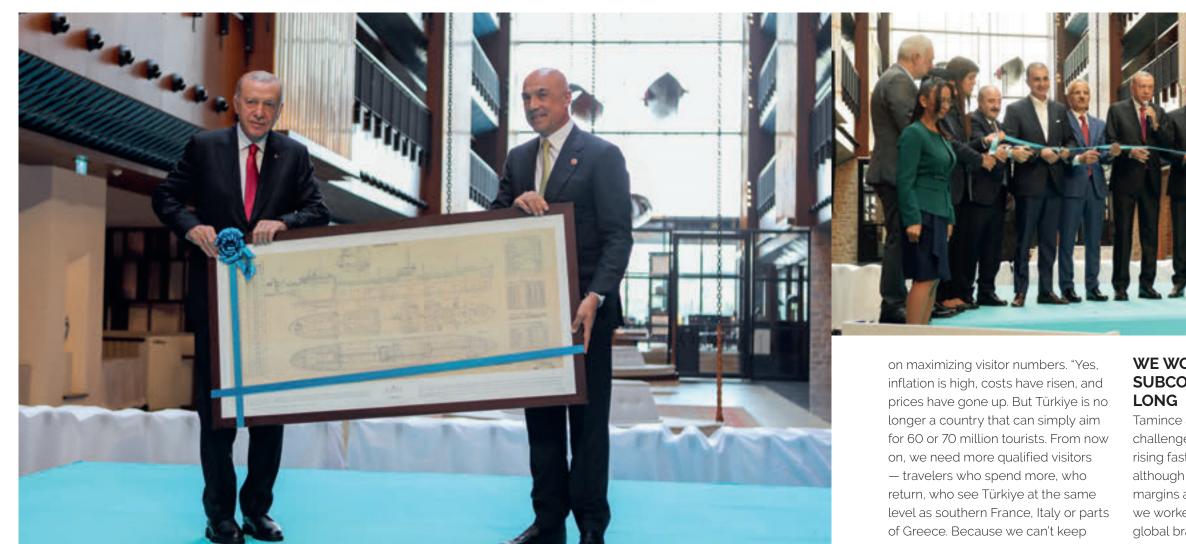

FETTAH TAMINCE:

TÜRKİYE CAN'T COMPETE ON CHEAP TOURISM ANYMORE

Rixos Hotels Chairman Fettah Tamince said that Türkiye can no longer return to cheap prices in tourism. "Time to plan the future differently" Rixos Chief says.



O25 is proving to be a difficult year for the tourism sector, according to Rixos Hotels
Chairman Fettah Tamince. Speaking to Güzem Yılmaz Ertem, Tamince said Türkiye has entered a "maturity phase" in tourism and is following a trajectory similar to other Mediterranean destinations.

IT'S NOT REALISTIC TO BE CHEAP AGAIN

Rixos Chief Tamince stressed that Türkiye should no longer focus solely on maximizing visitor numbers. "Yes, inflation is high, costs have risen, and prices have gone up. But Türkiye is no longer a country that can simply aim for 60 or 70 million tourists. From now on, we need more qualified visitors — travelers who spend more, who return, who see Türkiye at the same level as southern France, Italy or parts of Greece. Because we can't keep discounting. It's not realistic to take things back and make them cheap again," he said. Tourism in Türkiye, Tamince argued, comes with serious economic and environmental costs. "As you increase visitor numbers, you also pay a price — whether it's for infrastructure, roads, water shortages, air and sea pollution, or labor. Tourism is not free. Each visitor requires services that carry real costs, and those must be reflected accordingly," he explained.

TIME TO PLAN THE FUTURE DIFFERENTLY

Rising input costs over the past 2–3 years have put hoteliers under severe pressure, Tamince noted. "We cannot immediately pass all cost increases onto prices. The future requires a different approach: stronger branding, reaching higher-income groups, diversifying source markets. Right now, visitors are concentrated from certain regions, but the world is much bigger. We need to tap into that," he said, pointing to Rixos' own efforts to reposition its brand.

WE WORKED AS SUBCONTRACTORS FOR TOO LONG

Tamince acknowledged profitability challenges in the sector. "Our costs are rising faster than official inflation, and although we sell in foreign currency, margins are under pressure. For years we worked as subcontractors for global brands. Those who built strong brands can now sell their products at higher prices. Türkiye must follow the same path — otherwise relying on low costs alone is not sustainable," he warned.

On hotel pricing, Tamince argued that Türkiye remains competitive in its segment."At Rixos Premium Belek, a night costs around €1,000. It isn't cheap, but for the same standard of service in Spain, Italy, the U.S. or Dubai, you would pay two to three times more. In Egypt, we can offer a similar concept for \$400. Pricing depends on market, audience, and location. The key now is not just filling rooms, but attracting the right segment of tourists, especially from Europe and the Gulf," he said.

CONSTRUCTION COSTS HAVE RISEN 601%

Explaining why profitability remains low despite record arrivals at Antalya Airport, Tamince highlighted soaring investment costs. "Previously, building a hotel room in Antalya was onethird the cost of southern France or Dubai. Today costs are almost equal.

Construction costs have risen by as much as 601%. This pushes the return-on-investment period to 8–10 years, which reduces investor appetite," he noted

LARGE-SCALE INVESTMENT APPETITE IS LIMITED

Türkiye's economic environment,
Tamince said, also discourages
major new investments. "Everyone is
paying a price in the current economy.
Monetary policy remains tight, which
restricts access to financing. Even if
interest rates fall, accessing affordable
credit will not be easy. At current
commercial loan costs of 40–45%,
planning major investments is very
difficult. I expect some easing in the
second half of 2026, but until then,
appetite for large-scale projects will
remain limited," he commented.

10,000 JOBS TO BE CREATED AT TERSANE ISTANBUL

Tamince also discussed the group's landmark project, Tersane Istanbul. "The site will include a Rixos hotel, another under the famous American brand Delano, and our own new brand Aliee, which we expect to make a global impact. Alongside these hotels, there will be apartments, retail units, and museums. When completed, the project will employ nearly 10,000 people. It will be one of the largest real estate developments in the world," he said.

'Türkiye profitable destination for global hotel investors'

Türkiye has become one of the most accessible and profitable destinations for global hotel investors as the country's tourism sector shifts toward a high-efficiency model focused on renovation, branding and resale, according to a leading investment firm.



ot only buying hotels, but also renovating, branding and then reselling them at a higher value is now a much more attractive and profitable model for investors," said Murat Göktuğ Aksu, chairman of JRO Yatirim, the parent company of SellYourHotel.com and OteliniSat.com.

Göksel Akman, general manager of JRO Yatirim, said Türkiye offers opportunities for investors at all scales, from boutique hotel concepts to rental-generating projects, catering to both large investment funds and individual buyers.

Despite the negative impacts of global economic challenges and regional conflicts, including the Russia-Ukraine war and Israel-Iran tensions, Türkiye

has seen increased interest from global investors seeking to capitalize on tourism sector assets, Aksu noted. We Shape Our Investments Based on Guest Feedback

Okan Küçükmustafa, General Manager of Nirvana Dolce Vita Hotel in Kemer Tekirova, stated: "We have started collecting feedback for the 2026 tourism season. Our goal is to further improve services that our quests are satisfied with and to address areas they find lacking."

vüçükmustafa noted that the season started above

"Our hotels have been operating at 100% occupancy for about a month. We performed better than last year in both guest numbers and average rates. Demand is very high, particularly from Russia and Russian-speaking countries. In the domestic market, we also see a 5–10% increase compared to last year."

PRICES REACHING THEIR LIMIT

Addressing the impact of pricing on tourism, Küçükmustafa highlighted guest feedback: "Many guests say they love Türkiye, but now prices are stretching their budgets. Higher price



increases could challenge guests, leading to shorter stays. Guests who previously planned six-day vacations now prefer five days. Türkiye has reached its price limit."

CHANGING VACATION HABITS

Küçükmustafa also noted a shift in holiday culture: "People in Türkiye now prefer spending vacations in hotels rather than at summer houses or visiting relatives. Inflation and price increases affect consumers, but guests are unwilling to compromise on quality. They continue to stay in hotels within the same segment, adjusting

their budgets by shortening their stay rather than lowering standards."

INVESTMENTS GUIDED BY GUEST FEEDBACK

Emphasizing the hotel's commitment to renewal and development, Küçükmustafa added: "At Nirvana Dolce Vita, we make annual investments based on quest feedback. This year, we renovated some rooms and improved service areas. We have now begun collecting feedback for 2026, focusing on enhancing services that delight our guests and improving any areas they find lacking."

IN TOURISM, 'LUXURY' HAS GIVEN WAY TO 'ACCESSIBLE COMFORT'

Although Türkiye's tourism sector fell short of its targets during the high season, favorable weather has provided some optimism for hoteliers. M. Nihat Tümkaya, General Manager of Liberty Fabay in Fethiye, noted that the trend in tourism is shifting from luxury to "accessible comfort."

he tourism industry is the smokeless industry that brings foreign currency into Türkiye.
Following a rapid post-pandemic recovery, the sector is now facing a period in which suppressed exchange rates have reduced its price advantage compared to competitors. Regional conflicts have also negatively impacted tourism.

Regarding the claim that high prices of domestic facilities and international dining venues have kept local tourists away, leading to low occupancy rates, Tümkaya shared:

"Türkiye still offers services at approximately 15% lower prices compared to similar offerings in Europe. Our price-performance advantage remains strong. However, especially among fixed-income groups living in major cities, holiday planning is becoming more careful, and price-performance balance is increasingly important. The trend has shifted from luxury to 'accessible comfort.' At the same time, new comfort areas such as



spaces suitable for work-life balance, digital work, and quiet environments are gaining attention from these guests. High-income guests are also targeted.

"At our hotel, we closely monitor this transformation. We offer flexible booking options, early reservation benefits, and special campaigns to meet guest expectations. Our aim is to provide both an economical and satisfying sustainable vacation experience."

SUGGESTIONS TO REVITALIZE FETHIYE TOURISM

Tümkaya emphasized that Fethiye, with its natural beauty, climate, and cultural richness, is one of Türkiye's most special regions. However, in terms of destination marketing, it still lacks sufficient promotion. He suggested that yacht tourism, nature walks, paragliding, gastronomy, and other experience-focused activities need to be organized and promoted internationally to attract more visitors.

ERCAN ÇEK: DESPITE ALL CRISES, TOURISM REMAINS STRONG

Ercan Çek, General Manager of Sirene Belek Hotel and Vice Chairman of POYD (Professional Hotel Managers Association), shared his assessment of the current developments in the tourism sector and the general course of the season.



ek emphasized that despite challenges, the 2025 season has been successful in many aspects, noting that the sector continues to add value to Türkiye's economy and employment.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS, YET ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME

Çek highlighted that the results achieved despite global crises are remarkable. He stated: "The season continues at full pace. Looking at the global context, I believe Antalya tourism, and therefore Türkiye tourism, is going through a very successful period. Why do I call it successful? The ongoing Russia-Ukraine war has persisted for years. Expectations were high that it might end this year, but it didn't. Additionally, global developments like

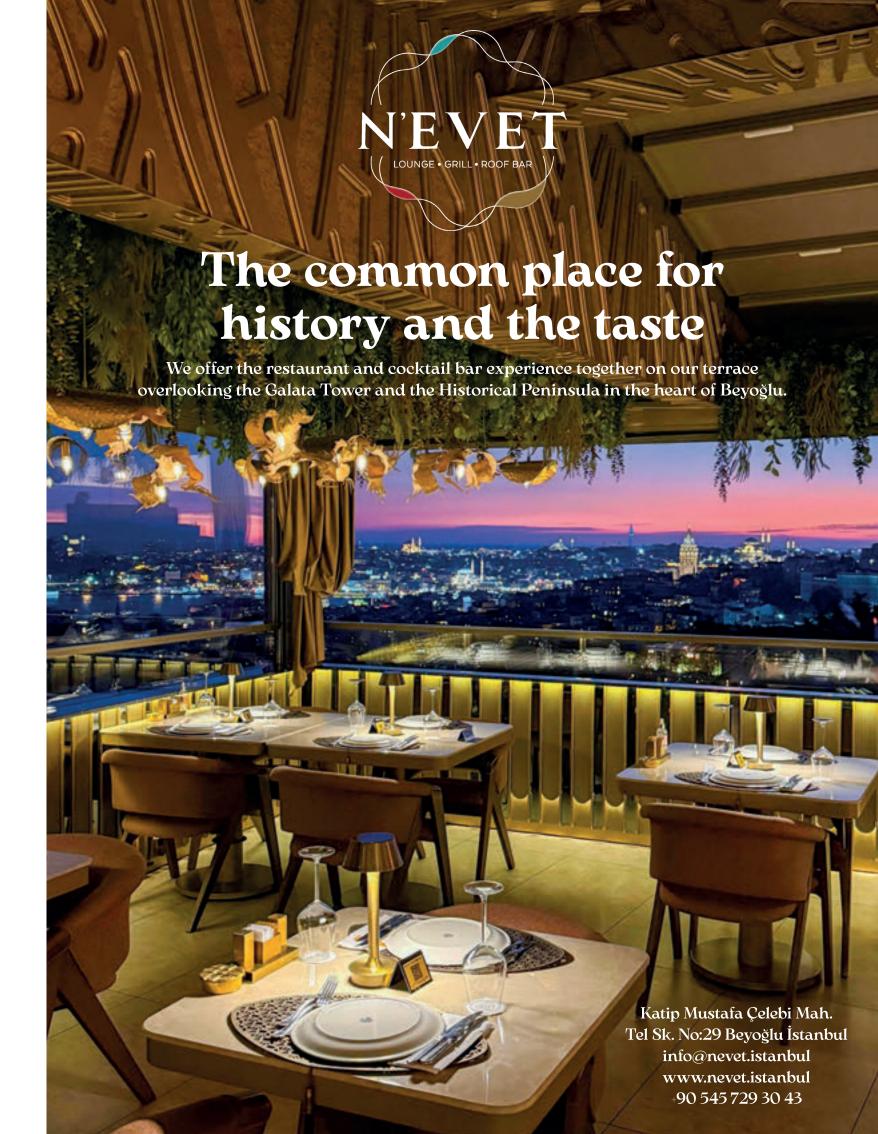
the Israel-Iran conflict occurred. Despite all these challenges, when we look at the numbers and occupancy rates today, the 2025 season shows a strong performance in both occupancy and revenue."

THE REAL ISSUE: EXCHANGE RATES AND COSTS

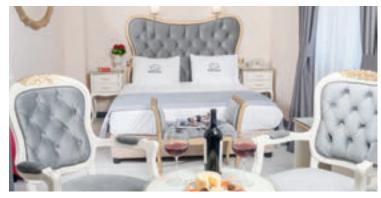
Çek noted that one of the sector's biggest challenges is the balance between foreign currency revenues and local costs: "Our revenues are in foreign currency, but our expenses are largely in Turkish Lira. This gap has widened significantly. There have been major increases in energy, water, and personnel costs, which affect profitability. Yet, despite all this, occupancy rates and demand remain strong. This demonstrates the resilience and strength of the sector."

WE MUST NEVER LOSE CONFIDENCE IN TOURISM

Underlining the indispensable role of tourism in Türkiye's economy, Çek continued: "Tourism brings in hot money, contributes to employment, and is resilient against crises. That is why we should never give up on this sector. We have experienced a pandemic, wars, and global crises, yet we are still standing strong. As investors and professional managers, we must continue to invest in both facility quality and human resources. Enhancing service quality, strengthening infrastructure, and prioritizing education are essential. As these steps are taken, the tourism sector will always continue to contribute to our country and its workforce."







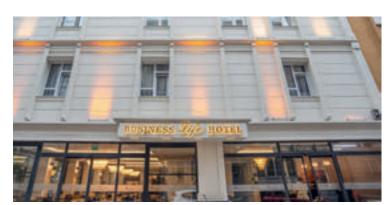
